EXPLOSIVES STORAGE OR USE PERMIT

Per the adoption of the 2003 International Fire Code in La Plata County per Ordinance No. 0-2010-01 an operational permit for explosives is required for the *manufacture, storage, handling, sale or use of any quantity of explosive, explosive material, fireworks, or pyrotechnic special effects within the scope of Chapter 33 of the 2003 International Fire Code*. The State of Colorado laws regarding explosives and pyrotechnics if more restrictive apply in all cases.
